FY2023 Center for Education and Research on Infectious Diseases (CiDER)

CROSS-DEPARTMENTAL "INFECTIOUS DISEASES" RESEARCH PROMOTION PROGRAM

This program is a cross-departmental CiDER program that promotes cutting-edge basic research aimed at fundamentally overcoming infectious diseases.

Currently, 36 proposals are already underway, and new applications are also being accepted for the start of FY2023.

Application Requirements

- (1) The applicant must be a principal investigator (laboratory director) at Osaka University and a principal investigator (project PI) of the research project for which the application is being made.
- (2) At least one principal investigator (laboratory director) who is mainly affiliated at a department of the University different from the applicant's main affiliated department should be included as a co-principal investigator in the research project (co-project PI).
 - * If the project PI and co-project PI are not a regular or concurrent member of CiDER at the time of application, the co-project PI will be required to be a concurrent member of CiDER after selection.

Major changes from FY2022

The research adopted in FY2023 will be conducted not only in the natural sciences, **but also in the humanities and social sciences**, as part of interdisciplinary research on infectious diseases!
