Outline	<p>The Center for Infectious Disease Education and Research (CiDER) at Osaka University is an organization dedicated to promoting education and research on infectious diseases, fostering human resources, disseminating information to society, and implementing research results in society. We are seeking for two up-and-coming, young Specially Appointed Associate Professors to conduct cutting-edge bio-medical research related to 'infectious diseases', and aim to have their own laboratories in the near future. 5 million yen will be provided for setting up the laboratory. 10 million yen /year will be provided for the employment of laboratory personnel.</p>
